Living Costs	Depending on each student's lifestyle. The average monthly costs of living in Kaohsiung are about NTD12,000, including housing cost.
Insurances	All exchange students are required to purchase medical insurance at their home country for their stay at least for 5 months in Taiwan. If not, It's mandatory to buy standard International Student Medical Insurance at NUK, NT\$500/month total 5 months. Who lived in Taiwan more than six months, are obligated to participate in the NHI system, NT\$826/month. Students are also required to have accident insurance when Studying in Taiwan. Student's Accident Insurance: NTD 500/per semester.
Administration fee	(1) One semester: NT\$3,000 (2) One academic year: NT\$5,000
